

Darren is a Past Grand Knight, Past Faithful Navigator, Former District Deputy, and Past Hudson Valley Chapter President. He is currently serving as Chairman of the Hudson Valley Conference. Darren has served as a State Chairman or Coordinator five times under four State Deputy Administrations. Darren has been involved with ceremonials as a degree team member for many years, as well as coordinating seminarian support through the RSVP program.

Darren is a graduate of Orange County Community College, holds a Bachelor's Degree from Syracuse University and a Master's Degree in Public Administration from Marist College. He is a parishioner of St. John the Evangelist Parish in Goshen, NY where he has served as a member and chairman of the Pastoral Advisory Council and on the Hospitality Committee. He is a member of St. John's Council #1106 in Goshen, and Francis J. Gorman Assembly #696. Darren resides in Goshen, NY with his wife Adene and their three wonderful children, of whom they are extremely proud.

Father McWeeney 2024 Award Honoree Father Thomas M. Colucci

Father Tom was born on December 20, 1955 in Bardonia, NY to Donald and Marilyn Colucci. Raised in Rockland County, he

attended St. Anthony's School, Nanuet, and Albertus Magnus Catholic High School in Bardonia, NY. In college, he attended SUNY at Cortland, NY, Springfield College, MA, and American University, Wash., D.C. studying physical education. Upon graduation he taught physical education for fours years. Then in 1985, he entered the New York City Fire Department. His first assignment was in Engine 81/Ladder 46 in the Kingsbridge Heights section of the Bronx where he was stationed from 1985-1994. Then he was promoted to Lieutenant in May of 1994, and he worked at Engine 3 in the Chelsea section of Manhattan from 1994-2002. In May of 2002 he was promoted to Captain, and was assigned to Ladder 21 in the Hell's Kitchen section of Manhattan where he served from 2002-2005. Upon retirement in 2005 after 20 years of service on the FDNY, he entered the Benedictine monastery of Mount Saviour in Pine City, NY. In May of 2009 he made his solemn profession, and that ensuing fall of 2009 he started theological priesthood studies at St. Vincent Seminary and monastery in Latrobe, PA. In the fall of 2012, he transferred to the Archdiocese of New York and entered St. Joseph's Seminary in Dunwoodie, NY. In December of 2015 he was ordained a deacon and served at Annunciation Church in Crestwood, NY for six months. On May 28, 2016, he was ordained to the priesthood at St. Patrick's Cathedral by Cardinal Dolan, having been the first retired New York City firefighter to be ordained to the priesthood. Upon ordination, he was assigned to St. Mary Mother of the Church in Fishkill, NY where he served from 2016-19. Then he was transferred to Most Precious Blood Church in Walden, NY in March of 2019 where he serves as pastor to the present. He is a 3rd Degree Knight, serving as the chaplain for Council #9254, and associate chaplain for the Hudson Valley Chapter.

Not just for some, but for all. Through Christ our Lord. Amen!


